## SRO-

NCS D is partnering with Casper law enforcement to promote the safety of students and staff in schools. NCS D is increasing the number of SRO's (Student Resource Officers) who are stationed in school buildings to be a visible security presence.

CCA welcomes Sergeant Jones as our new SRO. His office will be next to Mr. Teterud's office, and Jones will roam around CCA and other schools to promote school safety. Please welcome Sergeant Jones when you see him in the halls.

Also, SRO's may park out in front of the CCA building to be a visible presence.

If you see a police car out front, please know that it doesn't mean there is anything bad going on at CCA. SRO's connect with students and provide a visible security presence.


## 8th grade snacks


